Revision arthroplasty around the hip procedures:

- Posterior approach to the hip
- Plate osteosynthesis of posterior column
- Implantation of a hemispherical revision cup
- ETO
- Implantation of a modular revision stem
- Refixation of ETO with cerclage wires
- Interprosthetic fracture fixation
- B1 fracture fixation

Internal fixation procedures:

- Insertion of a distal femoral nail with lateral washer plate
- Interprosthetic fracture fixation
- Medial approach to the distal femur, double-plate osteosynthesis distal femur
