

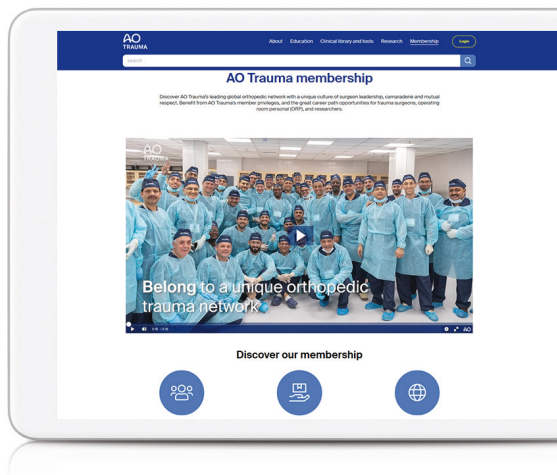
Join us to be part of the
